

GUIDELINES FOR PRESENTERS

Guidelines for Group Research Paper Presentations

Presenter Allocation

For group research submissions at AIRS, only **one designated presenter** is permitted to deliver the oral presentation for each paper. This practice aligns with widely accepted academic conference standards, where presentations are typically handled by a single speaker due to time constraints and logistical considerations. Conference sessions are tightly scheduled, and the use of multiple presenters may disrupt the session flow and complicate evaluation by the review panel.

Rationale

A single-presenter format ensures a coherent and uninterrupted delivery of the research content. Additionally, this approach supports the review panel in assessing presentation quality more consistently, as multi-speaker transitions can make comparative evaluation difficult.

Participation of Other Group Members

During the **Question and Answer (Q/A) session**, other authors of the group research work may contribute by addressing technical questions **with the prior approval of the Session Chair**. This provision ensures that discussions remain orderly while still allowing the research team to provide accurate and comprehensive responses.
